## **COVID-19 Reporting at TAA STUDIO**

If a TAAFT student or staff member has tested positive for COVID-19, is experiencing COVID-19 symptoms and thinks they may have the virus, or may have been exposed or had close contact with someone who has COVID-19, please follow the following instructions

**NOT FULLY VACCINATED:** Individuals who have not yet received both doses of a vaccine 14 days prior to exposure should self isolate and get tested right away. Individuals must self-isolate for 10 days, regardless of whether or not the test returns negative. It is also recommended they take another COVID 19 test on or after day 7 of the self-isolation process.

### **TESTED POSITIVE FOR COVID – 19 DO THE FOLLOWING:**

#### **Do not come to the studio**

1. Contact your Director or administration to confidentially report to [admin@torontoacademyofacting.com](mailto:admin@torontoacademyofacting.com) or phone 416.536 8574
2. Inform your professor and administration
3. You can return to the studio when you have self-isolated for at least 14 days AND have been 72 hours without symptoms
4. You will require a Covid test to be taken before being admitted back into the Academy

### **FEELING SICK OR HAVE COVID-19 SYMPTOMS**

1. **Do not come to the studio.**
2. Contact your physician or Telehealth at 1-866-797-0000 and or visit <https://covid-19.ontario.ca/self-assessment/>
3. Contact administration to report to [admin@torontoacademyofacting.com](mailto:admin@torontoacademyofacting.com) or call 416 536 8574
4. Inform your professor that you are sick so that we can put you on line to train
5. Self-isolate for 10 days if not fully vaccinated
6. If fully vaccinated individual is experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 they must self isolate and get tested right away. If the test returns positive, they must follow similar self isolating rules. If it is negative they can discontinue self isolation once symptoms have improved for at least 48 hours if the symptoms are gastrointestinal.
7. If advised, get tested
8. If a fully vaccinated individual is not experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 after being exposed to the virus, they are not required to self-isolate, although they should still get tested. They may also be required to get a second test. for the next 10 days they will just be required to self monitor for symptoms,

BEEN IN CLOSE CONTACT (less than 6 – feet, no mask longer that 15 mins) with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19

1. **Do not come to the studio.**
2. Contact your physician or Telehealth at 1-866-797-0000 and/or visit <https://covid-19.ontario.ca/self-assessment/>
3. Contact TAA to confidentially report to [admin@torontoacademyofacting.com](mailto:admin@torontoacademyofacting.com) or call 416.536 8574
4. Self-monitor for symptoms, self-isolate for 10 days
5. If advised, get tested
6. Inform your professor
7. You will require a COVID testing to be done after 10 days of isolation before you are admitted back to the Academy

BEEN IN CONTACT WITH SOMEONE WHO HAS SYMPTOMS BUT DOES NOT YET HAVE A POSITIVE TEST

In the event of a confirmed positive COVID-19 case(s) on campus, TAA will follow its Responding to Known On-Campus Exposure to COVID-19 Procedure and will maintain close and ongoing communication with Public Health. SWAC and OHS will coordinate with Public Health to manage and respond to individual cases of COVID-19 at the Academy.
